ANTONIO GALLONI - VINOUS – **Piedmont's Affordable Gems (Jun 2018) 90+ pts.** Just bottled, the 2015 Barbera d'Alba Morassina offers notable volume and resonance. At this stage, the French oak is a bit evident. Hopefully time in bottle will help the wine come together a bit more fully. Even so, I was not surprised to learn that in the future the Morassina will be aged exclusively in cask.

WINE ADVOCATE – end of April 2019- Issue #242- 90+ pts. “The 2015 Barbera d'Alba Morassina (with 8,000 bottles produced) shows an aged character with tar, resin and smoke on top of dried blackberry and prune. The wine still boasts a strong lifeline or pulse with dark and ripe primary fruit. What stands out is the elegant and downplayed nature of the mouthfeel that is delivered with carefully measured intensity.”

JAMES SUCKLING- **Monday, September 24, 2018 - 90 pts** A fresh and fruity barbera with blue fruits, orange peel and hints of flowers. Medium body, bright acidity and a clean finish. Drink now.

SLOW WINE GUIDA 2019- Dona il tipico sorso fatto di frutta matura vivacizzata dalla freschezza acida; invoglia a bere.

GUIDA VITAE 2019- 3 viti. Rubino insondabile. Mirtillo e tabacco, un fresco sottobosco fungino, divagazioni mentolate. Ha tutto per piacere: il rigore e la fantasia, la nettezza varietale ed il giusto tocco di savoir faire contemporaneo. Tutto da bere il sorso, persistente, fresco, d'irreprensibile integrità fruttata.

GUIDA ESSENZIALE AI VINI D'ITALIA 2020, by DOCTOR WINE/DANIELE CERNILLI: 93 PTS. Rubino granato intenso e vivo. Viola ed amarena al naso, con accenni spazati in sottofondo. Molto classico al palato, con acidità tesa e rinfrescante su corpo di ottimo peso. Finale di buona lunghezza.
