

BARBARESCO 2017

Recensioni e premi - Press and awards

JAMES SUCKLING – 93 pts. “A red with beautiful crushed-berry, earth and floral aromas and flavors. It's medium- to full-bodied with round tannins and a fruity yet fresh finish. Shows form and tension for this ripe vintage.”

WINE ENTHUSIAST – 91 pts. “Aromas evoking scorched earth, blue flowers, camphor and tobacco mingle together. The full-bodied palate features dried black cherry, blood orange, licorice and a hint of espresso alongside firm, fine-grained tannins.”

ANTONIO GALLONI - VINOUS – november 7, 2019 90 pts- “The 2017 Barbaresco is a new wine in the range and is made mostly from young vines in Rabajà and an older parcel in Trifolera. Floral, lifted and gracious, the 2017 is lovely. I would prefer to drink it sooner rather than later given its mid-weight structure. Hints of cedar, dried cherry, spice and crushed flowers linger on the delicate finish that offers good freshness for the year.”

Vertdevin Spring 2020 - 17.25/20 94-95/100 The nose is fruity, aromatic and offers a fine richness as well as precision. On the palate this wine expresses notes of fleshy Boysen berry, wild strawberry and small notes of plum associated with a touch of cornflower, violet, Cuben pepper as well as discreet hint of sweet spices. The palate is juicy, gourmand and offers a very fine crunchiness, an acidulous frame as well as precision/definition. On the palate this wine expresses notes of fleshy/juicy red cherry Boysen berry and small notes of juicy/fresh raspberry associated with fine touches of chocolate, caramelization, sweet spices as well as a subtle hint of tea and sugared mild tobacco. Tannins are elegant. Good length and persistence.

ErGentili- 20 luglio 2020- 90 pts giovanile nel colore, è piacevolmente fruttato – lamponi e ribes – nei profumi, ha un profilo non complesso ma di apprezzabile chiarezza espressiva; intenso e fragrante, è appena più caldo nel finale ma ha retto bene il confronto con l'annata.

WINE ADVOCATE – 23rd July 2020 – 90 pts The Giuseppe Cortese 2017 Barbaresco is a pure and direct expression of Nebbiolo with a delicate approach. Wild berry, violet and crushed stone mark the bouquet. The wine shows tight tannins and a silky feel that gives it an approachable, near-term disposition. You can pair this wine with egg noodles and truffle oil.
