ANTONIO GALLONI - VINOUS –september, 2021 90 pts. The 2017 Barbera d'Alba Morassina is a bold, powerful, old-school wine. These days the Morassina is done in a much more classic style than in the past, and that's exactly what comes through. Black cherry, licorice, dried herbs, game and melted road tar all open in the glass, perked up by bright Barbera acids. The 2017 is maybe a bit rough around the edges, but it is a transitional vintage to a new style that becomes clearer with the 2018. The 2017 spent 18 months in 60% cask and 40% barrique. It is best enjoyed at the dinner table.
